Temples are places for meditation and that's what Westjohn pretends: she wants us to meditate about the safe keeping of our resources.

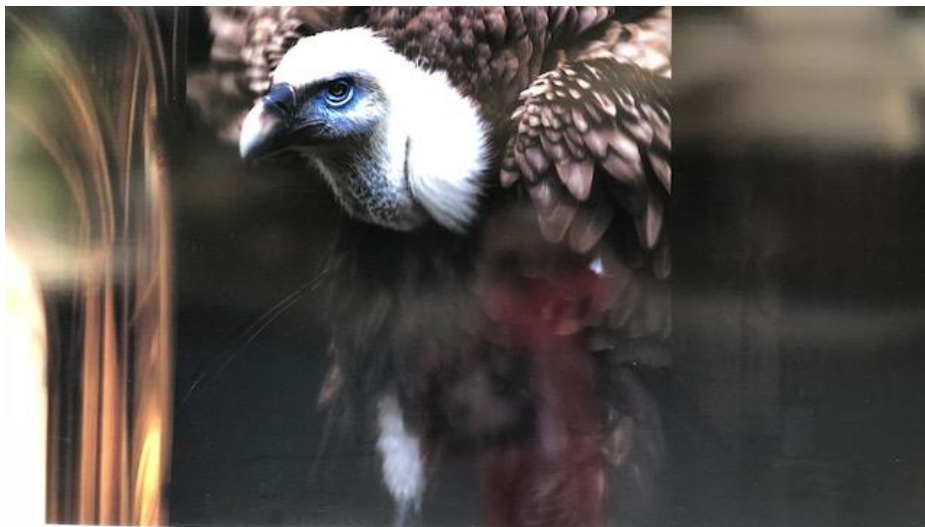

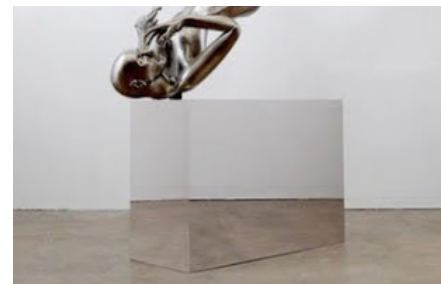

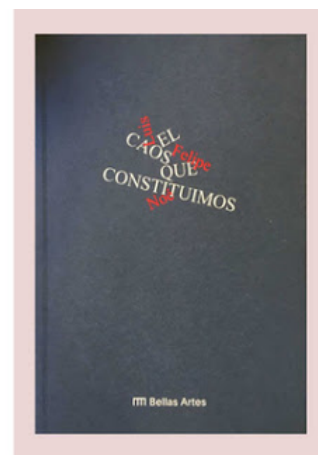
